Dermoscopy UK has been providing dermoscopy education in the UK since 2002. Since then over 3,500 clinicians have attended a Dermoscopy UK course.

Dr. Jonathan Bowling performed the first nationwide survey of dermoscopy practice in the UK in 2003. He presented his findings at the European Academy of DermatoVenereology in 2003. His results showed a lack of training in dermoscopy was a significant barrier to confidence in uptake and use of dermoscopy in the UK.

Over the following 17 years Jonathan pioneered and developed courses and delivered training in dermoscopy extensively across the UK.

His first courses were directed towards training dermatologists on dermoscopy. He then developed new courses to train GP's, particularly those with a specialist interest in dermatology and finally courses specifically for plastic surgeons.

In 2002 Dr. Jonathan Bowling provided the first UK training course in dermoscopy to 20 London-based dermatology trainees. Since that date he has lectured extensively on dermoscopy across the four corners of the British Isles at local, regional, national and international meetings.

He also is regularly invited to lecture and run dermoscopy courses overseas.

The Australasian Skin Cancer College invited Dr. Jonathan Bowling to co-run a dermoscopy masterclass at their annual skin cancer congress in Queensland Australia, in May 2017.

He is a regular invited faculty member of congresses including the World Congress of Cancers of the Skin, World Congress of Teledermatology and the World Congress of Dermoscopy.


Comply with NICE guidance

In July 2015 the British Medical Journal published the summary of NICE guidance for melanoma. The importance of accurate assessment with dermoscopy by clinicians trained in its use was made very clear.

All staff involved in skin cancer management, whether on the initial assessment or through follow up clinics, should take the opportunity to look for new skin cancers. These new skin cancers may not always be related to the index lesion, causing the initial referral, but may be covert additional skin cancers hiding and slowly developing in these high risk patients.

To find early skin cancers, all clinicians involved in skin cancer diagnosis and management should be trained in dermoscopy.*
